<b>luggage</b>	여행 시 사용하는 모든 짐을 포괄적으로 지칭	일상적, 일반적인 상황	"Is your luggage ready?" (짐 준비 됐어?)
<b>baggage</b>	Luggage와 동일하지 만, 더 공식적	항공사 규정, 공식적인 문맥	"Check your baggage at the counter." (카운터에서 짐을 맡기세요.)
<b>carry-on</b>	기내 반입 가능한 작은 가방	항공기 내 반입 시	"You can bring one carry-on bag." (기내 반입 가방 하나만 가져올 수 있습니다.)

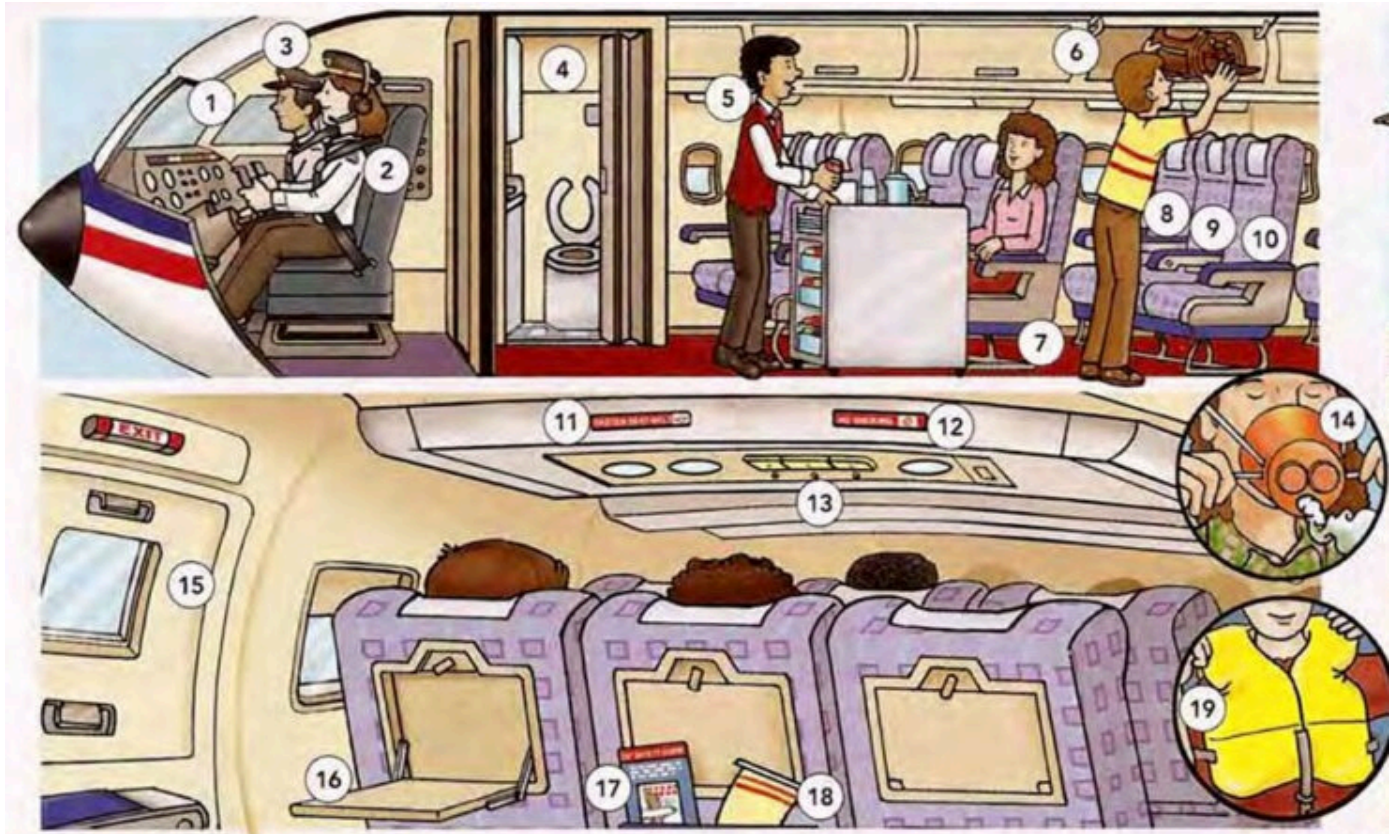
