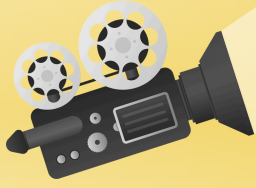

Movie Synopsis

"The Upside" is a heartwarming comedy-drama about an unexpected friendship between Dell, an ex-convict looking for a new beginning, and Phillip, a wealthy man who is paralyzed from the neck down and in need of a caregiver. Hired to help Phillip, Dell brings humor and new perspectives into Phillip's life, while Phillip provides Dell with stability and guidance. Through their journey together, they learn important lessons about trust, kindness, and overcoming challenges, ultimately changing each other's lives for the better.

Today's Expressions

1. No, I'm good. (Thanks)

Phillip: Why don't you have a seat?

Dell: No, I'm good.

- **Explanation**: This phrase is a casual way to decline an offer or say that you don't need help.
- **Similar expressions**:
 - I'm all set. 전 괜찮아요.
 - I'll pass. 전 사양할게요.
 - Maybe another time. 다른 때에 해요.
 - Not my thing. 제 스타일은 아니에요.

2. cut it out

Yvonne: Cut it out, man. No.

- **Explanation**: Stop doing that (often used to tell someone to stop a specific annoying or inappropriate behavior).
- **Similar expressions**:
 - stop it 그만해. 그만둬.
 - knock it off 집어치워. 그만해.

3. Why don't you ~?

Phillip: All right. So listen, why don't you take the night and think it over?

- **Explanation**: A suggestion or invitation for someone to consider doing something.
- **Similar expressions**:
 - Have you considered ~? ~를 고려해 봤어요?
 - It might be a good idea to ~? ~하는 것이 좋은 생각일지도 몰라요.
 - Why not ~? 왜 ~하지 않아요? ~하는 건 어때요?
 - How does ~ sound? ~는 어때요?

4. I just gotta have somebody sign it.

Dell: I just gotta have somebody sign it.

- **Explanation**: to persuade or order someone to do something
- **Similar expressions**:
 - I'll have Hudson show you to your room.
제가 Hudson에게 방 보여주라고 할게요.
 - Joan'll have the technician fix her computer.
Joan이 기술자에게 컴퓨터 고치게 할 거예요.
 - The director had the actor rehearse the scene multiple times.
그 감독은 배우에게 그 장면을 여러 번 연습하게 했어요.
 - The teacher had the students complete the assignment by the end of the day.
그 선생님은 학생들에게 그 날 안에 과제를 끝내게 했어요.
 - She had me doing all kinds of jobs for her.
그녀는 저한테 그녀를 위해 여러 가지 일을 하게 했어요.
 - I won't have those kids running all over my flowerbeds (= I refuse to allow them to do this).
나는 그 아이들이 내 화단을 뛰어다니는 것을 허락하지 않을 거예요.

5. **As a matter of fact,**

Dell: As a matter of fact, you should put your number down here just in case she wanna phone or check in.

- **Explanation:** Actually; used to emphasize that something is true or to introduce additional information.
- **Similar expressions:**
 - Truth be told 사실대로 말하자면
 - For what it's worth 도움이 될지 모르겠지만 / 참고로 말하자면

6. **All of these things to the right.**

Phillip: All of these things to the right

- **Explanation:** Refers to everything that is located or listed to the right of a certain point or position
