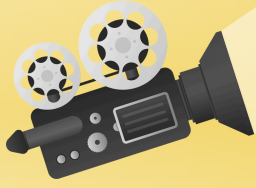

Movie Synopsis

In The Truman Show, Truman Burbank lives a perfect life in a small town, but he doesn't know his entire life is actually a TV show. Everyone around him, including his family, are actors, and his world is a giant set controlled by a man named Christof.

One day, Truman starts to notice strange things and realizes something is wrong. He discovers the truth and decides to escape the fake world he's lived in to find the real one. The movie shows the importance of living a real, authentic life.

Today's Expressions

1. **scrape together** 긁어모으다, 애써서 모으다

Truman: I figure we could scrape together eight thousand.

- **Explanation:** To gather or collect something (usually money or resources) with difficulty because it's scarce or hard to find.
- **Similar expressions:**
 - pull together
 - round up
- Examples
 - We don't have much time but if we all **pull together** we should get the job done.
시간이 많지 않지만, 모두 힘을 합치면 일을 끝낼 수 있을 거예요.
 - If you can **pull together** sufficient funding, we are prepared to approve the project.
충분한 자금을 모을 수 있다면, 우리는 프로젝트를 승인할 준비가 되어 있습니다.
 - Just **pull yourself together**. There's no point crying about it.
마음을 다잡아. 울어봤자 소용없어.
 - The cowboys **rounded** the cattle **up**.
카우보이들이 소떼를 모았어요.
 - I'll just go and **round up** Andrew and Patrick for the meeting.
제가 가서 회의를 위해 앤드류와 패트릭을 불러올게요.

2. **That can wait.** 그건 나중에 해도 돼요.

Truman: That can wait.

- **Explanation:** This phrase is used to suggest that something is not urgent and can be done later.
- **Similar expressions:**
 - put something on the back burner
- Examples:
 - The dishes **can wait** until after dinner.
설거지는 저녁 먹고 나서 해도 돼요.
 - The laundry **can wait** until tomorrow; I'm too tired to do it tonight.
빨래는 내일 해도 돼요; 오늘 밤에는 너무 피곤해요.
 - I'll **put** studying **on the back burner** tonight and just chill with my friends.
오늘 밤에는 공부를 뒤로 미루고 친구들과 편히 쉴 거예요.
 - I'm **putting** my social media **on the back burner** for a while. I am exhausted.
소셜 미디어는 잠시 뒤로 미루고 있어요. 너무 지쳤어요.

3. **have it out (with someone)** (누군가와) 터놓고 얘기하다, 결판을 내다

Waitress2: He has to have it out with Meryl.

- **Explanation:** To confront someone about a problem or disagreement, often to resolve it through an honest discussion or argument.
- **Similar expressions:**

- Clear the air (with someone)
- Examples:
 - I've been avoiding her, but I know I need to **have it out with** her about the incident.
그녀를 피하고 있었지만, 그 사건에 대해 얘기해야 한다는 건 알고 있어요.
 - If you're upset, you should **have it out with** her instead of letting it build up.
화가 났다면, 쌓아두지 말고 그녀와 해결해야 해요.
 - They **had it out with** each other last night, and now things are a lot better between them.
그들은 어젯밤에 서로 얘기를 나눴고, 이제 사이가 훨씬 좋아졌어요.
 - Let's **clear the air**; I don't want any tension between us.
솔직히 얘기하자. 우리 사이에 긴장이 생기지 않았으면 좋겠어.
 - We had a misunderstanding, so we need to **clear the air** before things get worse.
우리가 오해가 있었으니, 상황이 더 나빠지기 전에 분명히 해야 해요.

Truman: What the hell does this have to do with anything?

- **Explanation:** To be related to or connected with something; to involve something or someone in some way.
- Examples:
 - I'm tired; it probably **has something to do with** staying up late.
피곤해; 아마 늦게까지 깨어 있었던 것과 관련이 있을 거야.

- Does this problem **have anything to do with** the new app you installed?
이 문제가 네가 설치한 새 앱과 관련이 있니?
- I **have nothing to do with** her.
나는 그녀와 아무 상관이 없어.
- This **has nothing to do with** you.
이것은 너와 아무 상관이 없어.
- What does that **have to do with** me?
그게 나랑 무슨 상관이야?

6. **Bottom line is...** 중요한 것은..., 요점은...

Production Assistant: Bottom line is they can't drive the boat.

- **Explanation:** the most important fact in a situation:
- **Similar expressions:**
 - At the end of the day
- Examples:
 - **The bottom line is**, you should follow your heart.
중요한 것은 네 마음을 따르는 것이야.
 - I know you've been stressed about the exams, but **the bottom line is** you've done your best.
시험 때문에 스트레스를 받았다는 건 알지만, 중요한 것은 네가 최선을 다했다는 거야.
 - You can listen to everyone's advice, but **at the end of the day**, it's your decision.
모두의 조언을 들을 수는 있지만, 결국 결정은 네가 해야 해.
 - **At the end of the day**, just do what feels right.
결국, 옳다고 느끼는 것을 해.
